Competition B- MARATHON

The course is on roads, grass and along tracks. There will be 7/8 obstacles including 1 water obstacle

The times and distances below are for guidance only and all are subject to alteration due to conditions of class and/or ground and weather.

Section B	1km	Walk	6kph	7kmh
Section E	8km	Free Except for last 500m-walk or trot	13kph	14kmh

Competition C – CONES

The cones competition will be a fault competition.

The course will be between 500m and 800m with a maximum of 20 obstacles which may include a box. There will be no drive off.

Entry Conditions: Competitors must be full members of CDI/HSI or NICDA at the time of entry, (unless by special invitation).

Proof of insurance will be required from Non CDI/HSI members.

Age of driver: All competitors must be 10 or over (see CDI rules for groom qualifications)

Equines: Equines must be registered with CDI or NICDA

Equines must be at least 4 years old

Vaccinations must be annual and up to date

Entries: Entries will only be accepted on the attached National Championship Entry Form. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted.
