From Slane:

Drive towards Ashbourne for about 10.5 miles to Kilmoon Cross- “Cherry Picker Hire with yellow and dark blue fence on your right. Turn left, S/P Duleek and Drogheda - R152. After 0.3 of a mile, take the second turn on your right (the first is a cul de sac)- clipped green hedge, S/P Garristown. At the end of a ling straight, turn left at the T-junction. (New stone house facing you) At the next T junction keep right, S/P Clonalvy and Naul. At the crossroads, turn left, S/P Ardcath. In Ardcath, take the first turn right (No S/P) Stay on this road following the signs to Greenanstown to the next crossroads with a Stop sign. Turn left and the entrance to the event is the first field gate on your right. *6.6 miles from Kilmoon Cross*

From Dundalk:

Drive towards Dublin on the M1 motorway. Take the turn off for Naul. Arriving in Naul, Killien’s Pub will be facing you, turn right. At the top of the long hill turn left, S/P Clonalvy. After about a mile, take the first turn right. (No S/P). Downhill, take the first turn left, S/P Ardcath. At the cross roads turn right, the entrance to the event is the first field gate on the right. *3.7 miles from Naul.*

From Ashbourne:

Drive towards Slane for 5 miles to Kilmoon Cross-lots of white lines in the centre of the road-turn right, S/P Duleek and Drogheda. Follow directions from Kilmoon Cross as above.
