Entries / schedule: Entries are now taken. Schedule is attached. Please advise the secretary of special arrangements required (e.g. double entry/groom, etc) and of your estimated arrival time

Times: Dressage and Cones times will be depending on the number of entries, but dressage might start earlier than 12 noon on the Saturday. The Cones competition will run AFTER the dressage is finished.

Saturday evening: The prize-giving for Saturday's dressage and cones competitions will be held at the GALTEE INN, the square, Cahir within walking distance of the mart-site. There is food available a-la-carte and live music laid on later that evening for a bit of craic. Local obstacle sponsors have committed to valuable prizes on top of the usual rosettes. There will be "NEED FOR SPEED"

Catering: The event is taking place **IN** the town of Cahir, so there are many different places to get food and drink within walking distance. On Saturday there is a farmer's market in the Castle car park selling local produce, too.

Stabling: Please note that on-site stabling is available at the mart (mart pens under cover) at a cost of 20€ per horse, of which € 10 will be refunded if the stabling is cleaned out perfect on Sunday night. Off-site stabling is also available (limited) at 20€ per horse (non-refundable). Please provide your own bedding and feed. All stabling enquiries to Mossy Casey (0868096137) or by email to Mairead O'Donnell <mairead@caseystilesandfloors.com>.

Security access: As the event is in a built up area in the town, we have arranged for on-site security and access control to this site from before dressage start until after marathon finish. Wristband carriers ONLY will be allowed on site. Please indicate the number of wristbands you require BEFORE you arrive, with your entry. Up to 5 wristbands are given

out per competitor free of charge. Additional wristbands can be purchased at the entrance at 2€ each.

Distances: The dressage and cones field - and finish of section E - is located approximately 1 km from the mart site. The start of the marathon section A is directly outside the mart site. Section A is approximately 6k, section E approximately 9k. 4 obstacles are together approximately 2.5k from the mart site, the 5th obstacle is next to the dressage arena.

Please remember that the access to the dressage arena / cones field is through a ford of 30cm water. This water crossing is stewarded most of the time. 2 of the obstacles are also including water.

Safety: _____ As this event is taking place in and around a built up area, please ensure your and the public's safety at all times. You might inadvertently come across children, dogs or buggies, etc during your transit across the town: be patient and courteous! There will be stewards placed on all crucial locations, but we cannot provide 100% cover for all drivers. The timing will be generous enough for you to stop and let traffic pass, if needed.
