

**STOLEN FROM NORFOLK 22 NOVEMBER 2011
FULL SIZE 3 PHASE CARRIAGE BY WBR CARRIAGES,
ASHFIELD DRIVING CENTRE.**

Black and silver carriage with single front seat adjustable forwards and back, delayed steering with the **adjustment handle missing** from the drivers foot well, front and rear brakes and a handbrake with the knob missing from the panel under the drivers legs. **Sloping sideways facing seats in the back**, with faux leather padding that is laced on. Groom's grip handles, tape is a bit tatty in places. Adjustable rear axle. Ashfield's label on front of panel under driver's legs. Could perhaps be described as a marathon vehicle.

There is a **welded repair on one of the wheel spokes** (believed front right) and the left shaft is slightly bent and so difficult to adjust. There are **sanding marks on the back of the seat** where we were going to repaint around the fixings.

Most notably WBR only ever imported one of these and is not aware of any other companies importing the same item, so it is almost certainly the only one of it's kind in England. There are others that are similar, but not identical.

Also taken (on the carriage at the time) a set of multi coloured football cones, a pair of medium quick release shackles with zilco tags (on swingle tree), two rear and one front light, pair of classic Zilco breeching straps with parrot clips, please pass wide fluorescent sign, complete spares kit including (among other items): single tedex rein, single tedex breeching strap, single classic Zilco trace, Joker folding olive wood knife, cheap synthetic headcollar with suede inside nose and head piece, black leadrope.



And finally... A Bennington pleasure/competition carriage was also taken, 20 years old, black with varnished wood panels. Built for 14-15.2hh. No pictures available unfortunately.
